# Ordinance

05-12-29

An ordinance creating a new section of the Antioch Village code to create a permit to allow wine to be brought onto the premises of a restaurant

Our B.Y.O.B. Policy:

Serving is at the discretion of Ownership and Management

Section II A:

**Item1.** The permit allows only wine to be brought onto the premises

**Item4.** Only **one bottle per patron of legal drinking age** at a table or booth shall be allowed..

**Item5.** A **corking fee** may be charged for the service of opening and serving the wine, and will be posted in plain view during business hours.

**Item6.** Before opening, the wine **must be sealed in the original seal.**

**Item7.** The bottle must be commercially manufactured.

**Item8.** The bottle may not exceed 1000ML in volume.

**Item9.** The bottle must be given to staff **before** the patron is seated.

**Item10.** **No bottle may be returned to the patron** unless the staff has **re-corked** the bottle to make the cork flush with the top of the bottle. The original seal be set as close to the original condition as possible and secured to the bottle.

**Section III:**

**“4-2-12: TRANSPORTING ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS:** No person shall transport, carry, or possess or have any alcoholic liquor in or upon or about the passenger area of any motor vehicle except in the original package and with the seal unbroken.”
